The Warsaw School of Economics (SGH) is considered to be the leading university of economics and business in Poland.

## Programmes

International students wishing to obtain a degree can apply for one of the tuition fee-based study programmes offered in English:

- three-year Bachelor programmes in **International Economics, Management** and **Quantitative Methods in Economics and Information Systems**,
- two-year Master programmes in **International Business, Finance and Accounting (with opportunity of ACCA qualification)**,
- four-year **PhD programme in Economics and Management**.

Apart from the programmes offered in English, students can choose from nine Bachelor and twelve Master programmes in Polish. Over 300 courses are taught in English on both BA and MA levels as part of these programmes.
