Scores for additional scientific and sports achievements in the admission procedure to first cycle programmes with instruction in Polish

- 1. Rules for awarding points for achievements in school contests.
- Laureates and finalists of school contests at the central level stipulated in section 3 shall receive respectively a maximum available number of points in the qualification procedure (433 qualification points) or a maximum available number of points awarded for maturity exam subjects (333 qualification points).
- 2) Finalists of school contests at the central level stipulated in section 3 shall be obliged to take a test in entrepreneurship knowledge.
- 3) A list of school contests:
 - a. School Contest in Physics;
 - b. School Contest in Geography;
 - c. National School Contest in History;
 - d. National School Contest in English;
 - e. School Contest in French;
 - f. School Contest in Spanish;
 - g. National School Contest in German;
 - h. School Contest in Russian;
 - i. School Contest in Mathematics;
 - j. Knowledge about Poland and the Contemporary World.
- 4) Only the achievements of laureates and finalists of school contests organised on the terms outlined in the ordinance of the Minister of National Education and Sport of 29 January 2002 on the organisation and way of conducting competitions, tournaments and school contests (Journal of Laws No. 13 item 125, as amended).
- 2. The rules of awarding points in the School Contest of Entrepreneurship and the School Contest of Economic Knowledge.

- Laureates and finalists of the School Contest of Entrepreneurship shall receive a maximum number of available points in the qualification procedure (433 qualification points).
- 2) Laureates of the School Contest of Economic Knowledge who have been ranked in the first six places shall receive in the qualification procedure a maximum number of points available in the qualification procedure (433 qualification points); the remaining laureates and finalists of the School Contest of Economic Knowledge shall be awarded a maximum available number of points in maturity exam subjects (333 qualification points) and shall be obliged to take a test in entrepreneurship knowledge.
- 3. Rules of awarding points for sports achievements.
- 1) For the sports achievements enumerated below in points 1–8 in disciplines accounted for by the Polish Sports Association (according to the register of the Minister of Sports and Tourism) the candidate shall receive an additional number of points in the qualification procedure, but this sum of points may not exceed 433. Should a candidate meet the criteria of more than one achievements, this candidate shall have only the highest scoring achievement recognised.
 - a. 100 points participation in Olympic Games or Paralympics;
 - 50 points participation in a world championship or a European championship in the junior or senior category;
 - c. 40 points participation in the highest class competitions in the hierarchy of national league competitions in a given age category, in team sport games in at least one season in the last two years;
 - d. 30 points winning a medal in Poland's Championship in the junior or senior category in the last two years;
 - e. 30 points participation in the second level competition in the hierarchy of national league games in a given age category, in team sports games in at least one of the seasons in the last two years, if the hierarchy of a given league in the given discipline comprises at least three levels of games;
 - f. 20 points membership in the national representation in the junior or senior category in the last two years;

- g. 20 points participation in the best six team sports game teams in national Polish championship finals in the junior or senior category in the last two years;
- h. 20 points participation in the third level competition in the hierarchy of league games in a given age category, in team sports games in at least one season of the last two years, if the league hierarchy of a given discipline comprises at least five levels of games.
- 2) All achievements should be documented with original certificates issued by the relevant sports association.
